Melmoth is a town situated in northern KwaZulu-Natal. The town was established in the Mthonjaneni district after the annexation of Zululand by the United Kingdom in 1887 and was named after Sir Melmoth Osborn. Large wattle plantations were set up and a wattle bark factory was established in 1926.

Mr Xulu a member of the Melmoth Taxi Association saw the need for buses to service routes from outlying areas to the city. He then lobbied the Department of Transport, and proposed a solution which resulted in the birth of Mthonjeneni Bus Services (MBS), a company formed by members of the Melmoth Taxi Association and was awarded the contract which realised Mr Xulu's passion to provide bus services to the community of Melmoth and outlying areas.

The Challenge

Mthonjeneni had to start operating before their offices were completely built. The eBus team arrived onsite only to see that there was no roof nor electricity at the depot.

The Solution

eBus & Mthonjeneni worked together and made a plan.

The Result

All deadlines were met and Mthonjeneni started operations as promised to the Department of Transport. MBS continues to provide an exceptional service to the community of Zululand.
